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

Before we start, perhaps it may be best to clarify what QAPonline is

.

- Designed to survey the assessment skills of individual scientists in a laboratory in a way that provides virtual review of performance and the capacity to improve
- allow laboratories to compare their assessments skills of all scientists in either an
 - Internal environment
 - External environment
 - Peer environment
 - Selected grouped associations eg all labs in one country



What is QAPonline?

- Furthermore,
 - Allows each participant to review their own performance
 - allow supervisors to review results of all participating staff in each sub laboratories
 - Can and is used as an external QA scheme for accreditation purposes



- Furthermore, participation can be a several levels.....
 - □ As a student for training purposes but results ignored in data review.
 - As an Associate like a student in that results are ignored but designed to allow staff in one area to develop skills in an associated area.
 - □ Professional level core participation where subject is part of ones daily working environment
 - □ Peer where the supervisor designated one or more staff as the internal reference personnel.



- The reference range for the site is generated internally at various levels
 - As a standard comparison to all other professional.
 - □ Internal Peer Comparison all replies are referenced against the INTERNAL pool of peer participants.
 - External Peer Comparison all replies are referenced against the total pool of all peer participants.
 - ☐ Grandfather pool staff who have nominated their activity in the area of the scheme for more than 10 years.
 - National Peer group all replies are referenced against the pool of all peer participants in the same country as the participant (in development).




QAPonline - Staff Structure

- Therefore, QAPonline allows for
 - □ One laboratory participating a one QA program
 - Several laboratories within the company unit participating in one or more than one QA program
 - □ Selective participation of individual staff members in any combination of QA schemes at any skill level.



QAPonline - Staff Structure


The site can accommodate a single laboratory with a simple structure or a very complex series of sub labs – eg Embryology and Andrology labs






QAPonline - Staff Enrolments

The site can accommodate any combination of staff and enrolment in QA schemes.







- Individuals may move between clinics
- Personal record (but not clinics) can move with them
- Use in CV as proof of assessment competency.



- QAPonline is a series of QAP Schemes that are:
 - □ Grouped into disciplines
 - Andrology, Embryology, Ultrasound
 - Other areas eg Professional schemes
 - □ Each discipline contains one or more series
 - Sperm Concentration, motility, sperm morphology
 - Each QA series extends over several years.
 - Each year is a Scheme.




- Each Scheme is
 - composed of monthly assessment units
 - □ One or more per month
 - Each contains
 - an image, video or text/ task/ scenario
 - One or more quiz session
 - Each quiz contains
 - □ Several questions
 - One is the key question labelled






QAPonline System Design






QAPonline System Design eg Embryology





QAPonline Work Flow.







To create or join a QAP group, you can....

- QAPonline works as a company based QA system.
- To create a QAP group you first need to nominate yourself as a Supervisor.
- Locate the "Create a QAP group" link
- IF the QAP group exists and you wish to join it - then select "ADD MY NAME TO A QAP GROUP" to join.



 When you are a member of a QAP group, the top menu bar will identify both the home and company icon




Adding staff to your QAP group



- There are two ways to add staff to your QAP group

If you select



Adding staff to your QAP group



- Once you are a member of a QAP group, you can nominate which laboratory you work in (if the supervisor has created a record of your lab)
- Note, your name will appear on a clinic staff list for all to see...





Adding staff to your QAP group

- As supervisor, you can select 'Add Staff' from your supervisors menu and add a new staff member to your group dynamically
- You can also create a staff notice to send to staff about the subscription –
 - see 'Staff Notice'

Company Page (QAP group)



- When you are a member of a QAP group, a Company link will appear on the upper menu.
- Select Company button to see the QA scheme that are available.
- When you first create the group, there are no QA schemes available.






- To subscribe to one or more schemes... you need to
 - 1. Create the QAP group with a nominated supervisor
 - 2. Decide on which schemes and which staff are to be involved
 - □ 3. Decide on the type of subscription (see next slide)
 - □ 4. Find the subscription form
 - 5. Complete and post with payment (various formats)
 - □ 6. Send to FertAid.
 - □ 7. On receipt, FertAid will provide access to the scheme BUT
 - 8. Each staff member needs to enrol in each scheme at the correct skill level.





- The upper part of the form requests

- QAPonline allows individual subscriptions or clinic wide subscriptions where all appropriate staff members may participate.
- There are several free schemes, early QA schemes or training schemes that are not available through the clinic wide subscriptions.
- These can be access on an individual basais



Information about Joining a QAP Scheme.

QAPonline has been built around a series of modules. To access any module you need to join or enroll in it. To learn about to happens when you enroll read <u>How to Enrol</u>. Some modules are free but most require a subscription to join. If you wish to join a scheme, either you as an individual or the company you work with may join and in so doing allow you to select and join any of the schemes available to your company. If your company has subscribed, you can see the schemes available to you <u>Schemes I can join</u>.

If the scheme is free, you can join at any time and at no cost. See <u>list of free</u> schemes

These pages allow you to explore the QA scheme structure of QAP-online and how to enroll. You can always return to this page by selecting 'Join' on the upper menu.

From this page, you can

- view the review the structure of QAP online and the data hierarchy

- Selecting View QA
 Series produces a list of QA disciplines that contain active schemes.
- Remember that the structure of QAPonline is
 - Discipline (all series in one discipline)
 - Series (All schemes on 1 topic)
 - □ Scheme (annual scheme)





- Selecting a discipline then generates a list of all the QA series in a discipline. In this example, all the series in Andrology are displayed.
- Some are QA schemes others are educational





When you select a QA series, the annual QA schemes for the series are displayed.



Subscribing via Company Page

- If you plan to join via a company subscription, you need to complete a subscription form and send it to FertAid.
- FertAid will provide access to the schemes
- The schemes will become available on the Company Page.
- But each staff member need to join each scheme separately and at the appropriate skill level





- After you have completed the subscription form and submitted this to QAPonline with payment, the schemes requested will appear on the company page
- You can access previous years subscriptions by selecting 'Previous years'

If your company has subscribed over several years, you will have access to the previous schemes. Just select the year and the scheme and enrol in the standard way.



- It seems like there has been a lot of work just to get started.
- This may be true for the QAP Supervisor who needs to decide the type of QA and who should participate
- For each staff member, all they need to do is register and join the schemes
- This takes about 5 minutes after one has worked out how to do it.



- The essential aspect of QAPonline is that it is based upon an individual participation.
- This means that each participant has to enrol in each relevant scheme each year.
- There is a reason for this.....
- QAPonline allows a staff member to enrol at different skill levels over a period of time.
- That is as they develop proficiency, this should be reflected in their skill level



Joining a QA scheme – Skill levels

- There are four level of enrolment.
 - □ Student no previous experience
 - □ Associate working in the industry but not in the subject of the QA scheme.
 - □ Professional actively working in the subject of the QA scheme.
 - □ Peer selected by QAP supervisor to represent the skill level for internal benchmarking.




Joining a QA scheme -Applications of skill levels.

- This means that a staff member may be a professional in one scheme, a student in another and a peer in a third scheme.
- Also that a staff member may be a student in one year and after demonstration of competency, a professional in another.



- There are several ways to join a QA scheme
- The easiest is to select ENROL from the scheme list on the company page.






About Schemes



- The Enrollment menu allows you to navigate between different list options including
 - □ Different years
 - Different disciplines.





- Selecting the hyperlink to a scheme generates a list of all the monthly assessment tasks for that scheme
- This image demonstrates that all the instalments are displayed but
- Only those for release can be accessed.
- Instalments for future time periods can only be accessed when the time set points have been reached.




- One great feature of QAPonline is that it allows you to review your reply as soon as submitted.






- From the reply menu, a review of your performance for the whole scheme YTD is possible. Select *Performance Report*. This only reviews the QAP flagged question
- You can also create a new window with the actual data set available for your own number crunching.



The performance report is based upon the QAP question in the instalment




The standardised reporting module uses the QAP question for the scheme and is portrayed as SD units from the mean You can toggle between Internal and external Data sets at will.






- The standard reporting is SD units from the group mean
- Other information includes
 - Mean and SD
 - □ Range

- The performance report is created dynamically and is accessible at all times.
- There is a summary created at the end of the report.





Your performance for each instalment is described by a colour bar depending on the number of SD units your reply was from the group mean.

- The statistical summary is also generated dynamically with all current data.
- Test for goodness of fit (against expected normal distribution) and bias.





- You can also review your results by selecting Results from the upper menu
- This allows you to monitor your own performance for all questions not just the QAP question.





- Selecting results opens the results menu.
- This allows you to review your performance by individual schemes
- By monthly contributions
- By annual performance






- Selecting a scheme displays all the question in the scheme to which you have submitted a reply
- Selecting the QAP question generates a report the same as the previous performance summaries



 Selecting a multiple choice question generates a report as shown whereby the proportion of other respondents who replied the same as you is

displayed.





QAP Supervisor Options



- A key aspect of QAPonline is the capacity to monitor and review the assessment performance of each staff by the QAP Supervisor
- If you are the nominated supervisor, a Supervisor link will appear in the upper menu.





- On the company page, you are displayed as the QAP supervisor.
- In some clinics, the Scientific Director is not the QAP supervisor due to work load but
- He can be labelled as a Co-Supervisor
- This allows him to see the reports but not manage staff

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



- This can dissected by month or laboratory or staff
- Current or previous year reporting





 Selecting Annual key reports allows you to access all QA schemes in the selected year





- You can toggle between years using the little blue arrows.
- Select the hyperlink for the scheme you want



- This generates a report with the mean of your clinics assessment values by professional staff members against all the professional in the pool
- The report is the same as the individual performance reports





- Key features of the Annual Key Report are:
- Multiple reference comparison
 - □ All professional
 - □ Peer Professionals
 - Grandfather professionals
- Various graphical displays
- Review by Staff
- Review by Laboratory






- Other Supporting features of the Annual Key Report are:
- Scheme statistics including
 - Measurement of Uncertainty for each scheme
- QA Associations
 - Any clinic can create a subgroup within the data set eg all European laboratories




- The report
 - □ Displays your clinics stats
 - The overall stats
 - □ A Supervisors comment
 - A summary at the end of the report.
- The measure is your clinics mean value as SD units from the total data set.
- You can access each months data
- All student and associate data is not included.










Compacted report without statistical information











- Selecting the monthly icon, opens a monthly reporting module
- This allows the Supervisor to comment and "approve" a monthly QC data submission.
- For accreditation purposes.




- The monthly report
- Identifies each staff members contribution
- Compares the clinics data to the global pool
- Displays students reports (not included in the summaries).






From each month report, you can review the results for all questions in a selected instalment for a selected staff member.



From the main key report, you can review the performance of each laboratory






 You can also review the annual performance of each staff member (see below) in each laboratory





 From the Supervisors Reports Menu, you can select Staff Summary






Select a staff member





- Selecting a staff member provides a staff report for all schemes in a selected year.
- Data is the SD from global mean for each instalment as a one bar summary or.....





- .. An expanded report for each instalment.
- A Summary is located at the end of the report.

In summary....

- QAPonline provides a laboratory with
 - □ Tools to monitor the skills of their staff in key assessment fields
 - Mechanism to manage an EQA for accreditation purposes
 - Tools to educate and improve individuals performance to achieve improved laboratory performance,





- FertAid sees the EQA functions as an endpoint of managing ones own QC or Internal Auditing activities.
- The EQA focuses on individuals rather than on clinics
- The EQA uses the Internet to deliver uniform tools for assessments as opposed to the use of physical specimens.
- Consequently, FertAid's EQA schemes can act independent or in conjunction with other EQA schemes.
